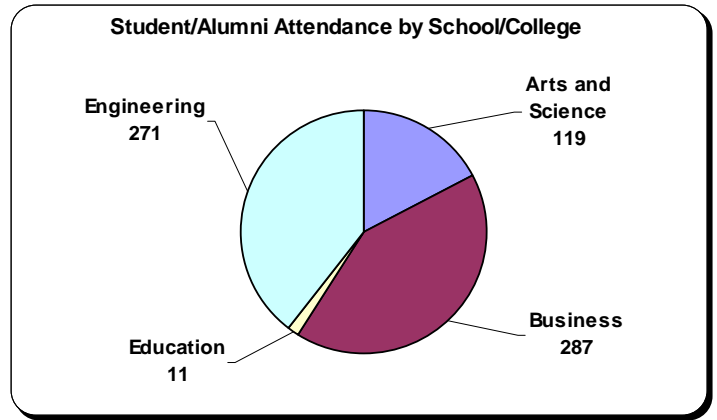
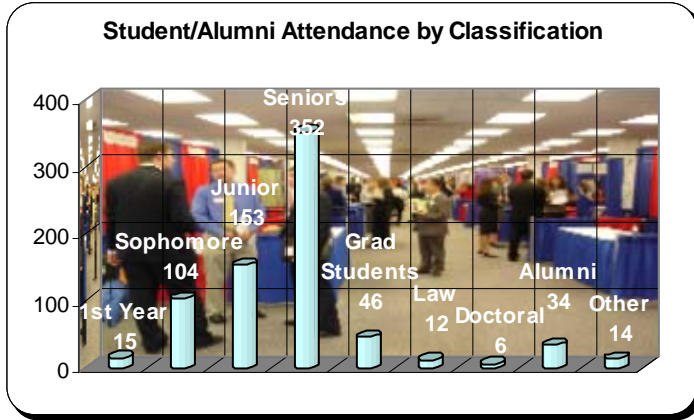


Fall 2007 Career and Grad School Fairs

Day 1 Student Attendance - 736



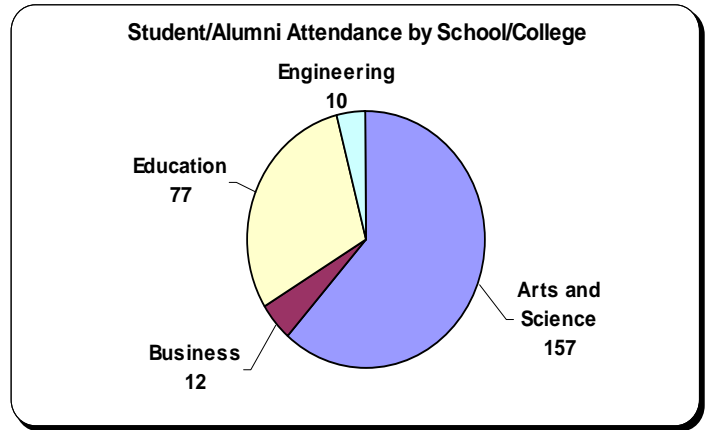
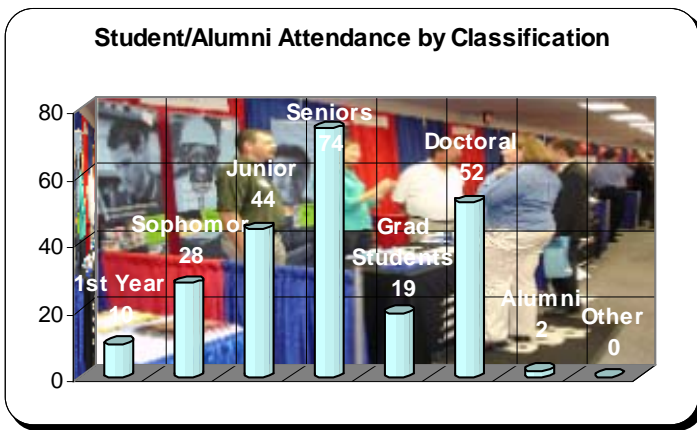

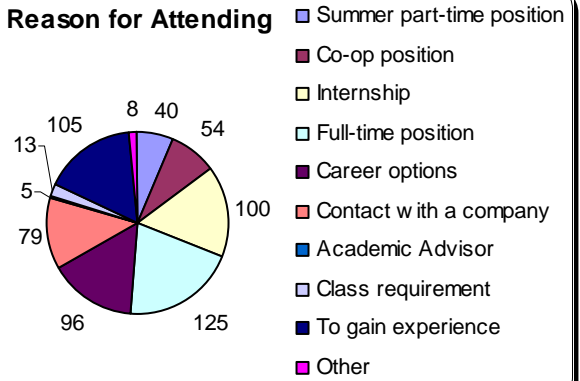

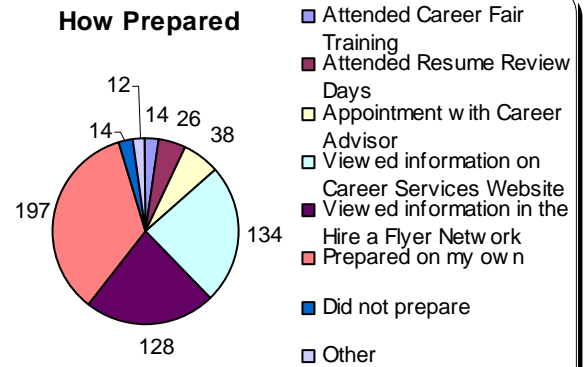
Reason for Attending

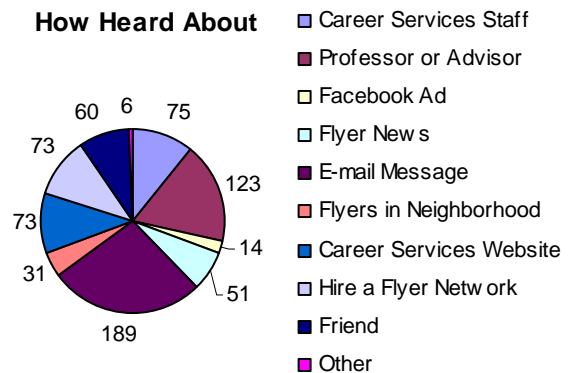
How Prepared



How did you hear about the Career Fair? (May choose more than one.)

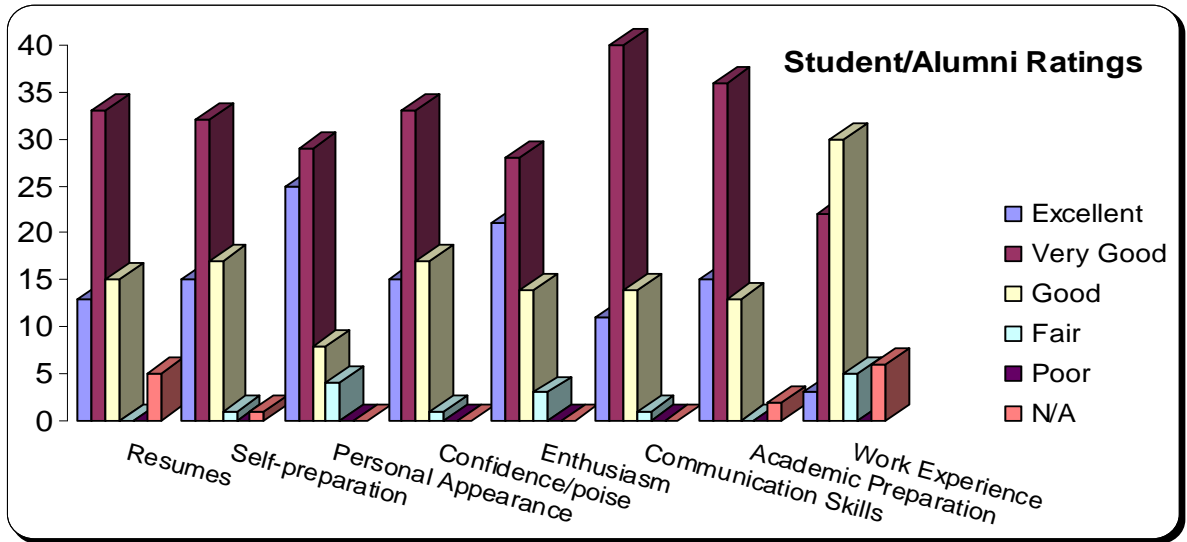
